

**Haverhill PAL Soccer**  
**Coach's Child Fee Waiver Requirement**  
**Effective August 2010**

As an added incentive for people to volunteer to coach and for retention of trained and experienced coaches, Haverhill PAL Soccer offers fee waivers for players whose parents are coaching their child's team, have coached for two consecutive seasons and have at least 4 hours of age-appropriate training.

Age-appropriate training as defined by Haverhill PAL Soccer is as follows:

- U5, U6, U7 → "G" certification from Mass Youth Soccer
- U8, U10 → "F" certification from Mass Youth Soccer
- U12, U14 → "E" certification from Mass Youth Soccer

Upon successful completion and verification (i.e. copy of completion certificate and receipt submitted to Haverhill PAL Director of Player/Coach Development) of training courses G, F or E; Haverhill PAL Soccer will reimburse the course fee.

If the coach meets the requirement outlined above and coaches his/her child's team, Haverhill PAL Soccer agrees to reimburse or waive the registration fees for that season for any of the coach's children playing on the team that he/she is coaching.

"Online G" certification is a great way to become introduced to coaching youth soccer but does not constitute 4 hours of age-appropriate training. Thus, the coach's child waiver and/or reimbursement for the online G will not be honored until successful completion of the subsequent "F" course (or age-appropriate training as outlined above).
