

Attendance Policy

Player Commitment:

The Travel Program expects each player to commit to playing **both the Fall and Spring season**. Travel soccer is played at a higher level of competition than In-Town. This competitive level requires the player to be committed to attending all practices and games. Travel teams typically schedule two 90-minute practices and all players need to attend. Soccer is a team sport and the player needs to know the team's philosophy and his/her responsibility within the team.

Players who earn a roster position on one of our top teams, division 1 or 2, in any age group will be required to attend **75%** of all league games and team practices for both the Fall and Spring seasons. Players who become injured, or have some type of prolonged physical condition, which prevents him/her from playing, will not be held to this level of commitment during the season in which this condition occurs.

Player(s) who are not willing to commit to this level of participation will be offered places on our lower level travel team, division 3, or in our In-Town program as appropriate.

Player(s), who fail to meet the committed level of participation in a season, may be placed on a lower level travel team, division 3, or on an In-Town roster at the discretion of our player selection committee.

Your completion of the registration form indicates your awareness of the Attendance Policy and acknowledges your willingness to commit to the level of participation outlined above.
